On Wednesday, August 18, 2010, representatives from South Florida Racing Association, LLC (SFRA) and the Florida Quarter Horse Racing Association (FQHRA) convened at Hialeah Park to begin negotiating a binding agreement to encompass, at a minimum, the impending race meet at Hialeah Park scheduled to commence on Friday, November 26, 2010 and conclude on January 2, 2011, for a total of twenty-two (22) live race days. These contractual negotiations were finalized on Monday, August 30, 2010, yielding an agreement for a term of six (6) years.

During the aforementioned discussion, several salient points were put forth regarding the start date and duration of the SFRA scheduled race meet. At this time, the original DBPR PMW 3190 form previously submitted on December 30, 2009, remains unchanged.
